

Monday vhf/uhf Script notes

Sample pre-amble:

(Five minutes before the net, enter the BeachNet system and state:)

QST QST QST The Wahkiakum Informal Training net will begin in five minutes. (callsign)

(At 6:30, come on the air and say:)

Good evening this is (n7wah) calling the Wahkiakum County Amateur Radio Club Informal Training Net.

My handle is (your name), my callsign is (state callsign using phonetics), I am located in (state location, such as Puget Island), and I am using the (444300 repeater you are using, such as Nicolai).

We will break anytime for emergency or priority traffic.

Anyone is welcome to check in. When you check in please give your callsign, your name and say through which repeater you are accessing the BeachNet system.

Any check-ins, Please come now.

(continue taking and acknowledging check-ins until all are done - usually 5 to 10).

(when all check-ins are done, make any announcements, then state:)

Thanks for the use of the BeachNet repeater system. We will now QSY to 145.550 simplex where we will again take check-ins from all who can make it.

(QSY to 145.550)

This is (callsign) (name) taking check-ins for the Wahkiakum Informal Training net on simplex. Please come now with your callsign and name.

(continue taking and acknowledging check-ins until all are done - usually 4 to 6).

(ask someone on the east end of the county, usually Steve K7SH, to make a call.)

(ask someone on the west end of the county, usually Peter KI7YMM, to make a call.)

(When all are done, state:)

Thanks everyone for checking in. I hope to see you tomorrow at our club meeting. (callsign) clear.
